1 Corinthians 13:1-8 (NKJV)
1 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels (Words of affirmation), but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal.

2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains (Acts of service), but have not love, I am nothing.

3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor (Receiving gifts), and though I give my body to be burned(Personal touch), but have not love, it profits me nothing.

4 Love suffers long and is kind (Quality time); love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up;

5 does not behave rudely, **does not seek its own**, is not provoked, thinks no evil;

6 does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth;

7 bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

8 Love never fails.
